

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 256-11 B. (3) OF THE MOUNT VERNON CITY CODE ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

WHEREAS the Commissioner of Parking requested that City Council amend Chapter 256-11 B. (3) of the Mount Vernon City Code so that future offenders who own commercial vehicles or who own vehicles over the weight of 5,500 pounds will be prevented from parking in the City of Mount Vernon between the hours of 7:00 pm and 6:00 am. The City Council wants to make it clear that this legislation should be interpreted disjunctively.

The City of Mount Vernon, in City Council convened, does hereby ordain and enact:

Section 1. Amendment

Chapter 256-11 B. (3) of the Mount Vernon City Code, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic," is hereby amended to read as follows:

Chapter 256-11 B.

(3) Signs.

- (a) The Department of Public Safety is hereby authorized and directed to erect signs at [each and] every entrance to the City of Mount Vernon indicating no parking for all vehicles over the weight of 5,500 pounds or [and] commercial vehicles on any public highway in the City of Mount Vernon between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
- (b) When official signs prohibiting parking are erected at the entrances to the City of Mount Vernon as authorized herein, no person shall park a vehicle over the weight of 5,500 pounds or a commercial vehicle upon any street in the City of Mount Vernon in violation of such signs.

Section 2. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
