A LOCAL LAW OF THE TOWN OF MONTGOMERY, COUNTY OF ORANGE, AMENDING CHAPTER 162 OF THE TOWN CODE ENTITLED-"NOISE"

LOCAL LAW NO. 5 OF 2023

A LOCAL LAW OF THE TOWN OF MONTGOMERY, COUNTY OF ORANGE, AMENDING CHAPTER 162 OF THE TOWN CODE ENTITLED-"NOISE"

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF MONTGOMERY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Purpose

The Town Board of the Town of Montgomery recently enacted Town Code Chapter 162 entitled "Noise" to establish regulations concerning the emission of noise within the Town to permit all residents of the Town to peacefully enjoy their properties without being disturbed by excessive noise emanating from other properties or sources. Following enactment of the aforesaid, Chapter, the Town Board wishes to make certain amendments to the definitions of certain zones within the law as set forth herein.

Section 2.

The Town Code Chapter 162 entitled: "NOISE" is hereby amended as follows:

§ 162-3. Definitions.

Modify the language in the definitions section as set forth herein: As used in this chapter, the following terms and phrases shall have the following meanings:

BUSINESS ZONE

Business and industrial zonesB 1 District (neighborhood business), B 4 District (highway commercial), OB District (office business), OP District (office park) and IB District (interchange business) as set forth in § 235-5.1(B) of the Code of the Town of Montgomery and all uses associated therewith either permitted as a right or as a special use.

INDUSTRIAL ZONE

Business and industrial zones ID District (interchange commercial and industry), I-1 District (industrial park), I-2 District (industrial park major access), I-3 District (general industry) and I-4 District (general industry-A) as set forth in §235-5.1(B) of the Code of the Town of Montgomery and all uses associated therewith, either permitted as a right or as a special use.

RESIDENTIAL ZONE

Residential districts as Those residential districts set forth in §235-5.1(A) of the Code of the Town of Montgomery as RA-CE District (residential agricultural—conservation easement), RA-5 District (residential agriculture—one-family residences), RA-1 District (residential

agriculture—one—and two-family residences), RA-2 District (residential agriculture—one—and two-family residences), RA-3 District (residential agriculture—one—and two-family residences), RM-1 District (multi-family), R—MHC District (mobile home court), MHP-AR District (Mobile home park—age restricted floating district), RA-2/PAC District (planned adult community) and RA-3/PAC District and all uses associated therewith either permitted as a right or as a special use.

RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICT

Any zoning district in which one-family detached dwellings or one-family and multifamily dwellings are permitted principal uses, including those set forth in §235-5.1(A) of the Code of the Town of Montgomery. zoning districts RA CE, RA .5, RA 1, RA 2, RA 3, RM 1, R MHC, MHP AR, RA 2/PAC and RA 3/PAC.

Section 3. Separability

If any provision of this local law or the application thereof to any person or circumstance be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be confined in its operation to the part or provision or application directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered and shall not affect or impair the validity of the remainder of this local law or the application thereof to other persons or circumstances, and the Town Board of the Town of Montgomery hereby declares that it would have passed this local law or the remainder thereof had such invalid application or invalid provision been apparent.

Section 4. Repeal

All ordinances, local laws and parts thereof inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
