ORDINANCE NO. 2777

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MONROEVILLE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING ARTICLE VII, SECTION 701, OF THE HOME RULE CHARTER TITLED MUNICIPAL MANAGER - APPOINTMENT, QUALIFICATIONS AND COMPENSATION OF THE MUNICIPAL MANAGER, TO INCREASE THE MANAGEMENT EXPERIENCE QUALIFICATIONS AND DELETE THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR THE POSITION OF MUNICIPAL MANAGER.

WHEREAS, The Municipality is engaged in a search for a Municipal Manager to replace the existing Municipal Manager who is retiring on or about January 2, 2024;

WHEREAS, The Municipality has engaged Public Partners to assist in the process of identifying and interviewing qualified candidates for the Municipal Manager position;

WHEREAS, Public Partners has reviewed the qualifications for the Municipal Manager set forth in the Home Rule Charter, and has advised the Municipality that the present qualifications set forth in the Home Rule Charter may substantially limit the pool of qualified candidates;

WHEREAS, Municipal Council has determined that it is in the Municipality's interest to attract the widest range of qualified candidates by making certain amendments to the existing qualifications set forth in the Home Rule Charter;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment to Article VII, Section 701 of the Home Rule Charter.

Article VII, Section 701 of the Home Rule Charter is amended to read:

“The Council shall, by Ordinance pursuant to Section 506, appoint a Municipal Manager pursuant to Sections 1142 and 1143 of the Pennsylvania Borough Code, as amended. The Manger shall be appointed solely on the basis of executive and administrative Manager's qualifications and shall have at least eight (8) years of municipal management experience, including five (5) years' experience as a Manager or Assistant Manager, or a combination thereof. The Manager shall have a Bachelor's degree, with a Master's degree desirable, in Public of Business Administration, or a related field from an accredited college or university.”

Section 2. Severability.

If any section, sub-section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Repealer.

Any ordinance, chapter, section, sub-section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase conflicting with the provisions set forth in this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict for the time period identified herein.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption by Municipal Council and ratification pursuant to Section 2942 of the Home Rule Charter and Optional Plans Law, 53 Pa. C.S. § 2901 et. seq.





SPECIAL ELECTION QUESTION**


