The following sections of Chapter 156 are hereby amended as follows:

Chapter 156-21

A. Residential Water Rates

(1). Water rates inside the Village

- a) Base charge: \$ 3.20
- b) From one gallon to 9,999,900 gallons: \$ 0.745 per 100 gallons.

(2). Water rates outside the Village

- a) Base charge: \$ 6.40
- b) From one gallon to 9,999,900 gallons: \$ 1.490 per 100 gallons.

(3). Sewer Rates

- a) Sewer unit charge: \$ 280.75 per unit per year (Note: One unit is equal to 41,464 gallons per year, the sewer charge is divided equally by the number of billings per year and is included with the bill.)
- b) From one gallon to 9,999,900 gallons: \$ 1.175 per 100 gallons.
- c) Base Charge: \$ 3.56

B. Commercial Water Rates

(1). Water rates inside the Village

- a) Base charge: \$ 1.60
- b) From one gallon to 9,999,900 gallons: \$ 1.000 per 100 gallons.

(2). Water rates outside the Village

- a) Base charge: \$ 3.20
- b) From one gallon to 9,999,900 gallons: \$ 2.000 per 100 gallons.

(3). Sewer Rates

- a) Sewer unit charge: \$ 280.75 per unit per year (Note: One unit is equal to 41,464 gallons per year, the sewer charge is divided equally by the number of billings per year and is included with the bill.)
- b) From one gallon to 9,999,900 gallons: \$ 1.550 per 100 gallons.
- c) Base Charge: \$ 1.78
