SECTION 1.

So that a new Chapter 39, titled "Village Offices, Appointed," shall be created, which shall read, in its entirety, as follows:

"§ 39-1 Village Clerk-Treasurer, Deputy Clerk and Deputy Clerk-Treasurer.

Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 3 of the Village Law, each person designated as Clerk-Treasurer, Deputy Clerk, and Deputy Clerk-Treasurer need not be a legal resident or elector of the Village of Morrisville provided, however, that such person(s) shall reside in the County of Madison. The position of Village Clerk-Treasurer shall be unclassified for purposes of Civil Service. The positions of Deputy Village Clerk and Deputy Village Clerk-Treasurer shall be exempt for purposes of Civil Service. In the case of vacancy in these offices, and upon direction to fill the vacancy by the Board of Trustees, the Mayor shall appoint a qualified person to fulfill the remaining term of the Clerk-Treasurer, Deputy Clerk, or Deputy Clerk-Treasurer.

§ 39-2 Appointed Village officers.

Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 3 of the Village Law, any appointed Village officer need not be a legal resident or elector of the Village of Morrisville, provided that such person(s) shall reside in the County of Madison."

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY.

If the provisions of any article, section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Local Law shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgement shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any article, section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Local Law.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall be effective upon filing with the office of the Secretary of State.
