ORDINANCE REPEALING AND RECREATING SUBSECTION 9-2-15 OF THE MONROE CITY CODE: INJURY TO PROPERTY BY ANIMALS

THE COUNCIL of the city of Monroe does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Subsection 9-2-15 of the Monroe City Code is hereby repealed and re-created as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person owning, keeping, harboring, or having custody of an animal to permit such animal to go upon any public or private premises without the permission of the owner of such premises and break, bruise, tear up, crush or injure any lawn, flower bed, plant, shrub, tree or garden in any manner.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be in full force on the day following passage and official publication.
