ORDINANCE NO: 1345

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF A FOUR-WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION BETWEEN AND BEHIND THE 500 BLOCK OF STATE STREET AND RAILROAD STREET, MOUND CITY, MISSOURI AND ALSO TO DESIGNATE THE PORTION OF THE ALLEYWAY BETWEEN 511 STATE STREET AND 515 STATE STREET, MOUND CITY, MISSOURI, EXTENDING TO THE FOUR-WAY INTERSECTION AS ONE-WAY.

WHEREAS, the four-way intersection running between and behind the 500 Block of State Street and Railroad Street, Mound City, Missouri does not currently have any traffic signs; the City, for the safety of the community would like to install Stop signs to create a four-way stop; and

WHEREAS, the portion of the alleyway between 511 State Street and 515 State Street, Mound City, Missouri, extending to the four-way intersection is currently considered at two-way traffic area, the City, for the safety of the community would like to designate this area for one-way traffic only.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MOUND CITY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Board of Aldermen of Mound City, Missouri hereby approves the installation of Stop signs at the four-way intersection running between and behind the 500 Block of State Street and Railroad Street, Mound City, Missouri to create a four-way stop.

Section 2. The Board of Aldermen of Mound City, Missouri hereby approves the designation of the portion of the alleyway between 511 State Street and 515 State Street, Mound City, Missouri, extending to the four-way intersection as a one-way traffic area.


Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
