**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NO PARKING ON FRIDAY OF EACH WEEK AT
THE DEAD END OF FERCHLAND PLACE**

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Monona to protect the public health, safety, and welfare; and,

WHEREAS, residential garbage collection is scheduled for collection on Fridays of each week; and,

WHEREAS, on several occasions this year, collection on Ferchland Place could not take place because automobiles and construction trailers have been parked at the dead end of, preventing the collection trucks from executing a proper Y-turn movement to turn around and collect residential carts for disposal; and,

WHEREAS, to address this issue, staff is recommending parking restrictions be put in place at the Ferchland Place dead end indicating “No Parking, 7:00am to 5:00pm, Friday of Each Week”; and,

WHEREAS, parking restrictions would be enforced under the Code of the City of Monona, Chapter 434, Article III Parking Regulations; and,

WHEREAS, based upon the recommendations of city staff and the Public Works Committee, the Common Council finds it in the public interest to establish parking restrictions as the location stated below.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Monona, Dane County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

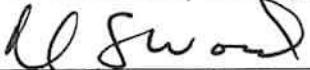
SECTION 1. Street parking is hereby restricted at the dead end of Ferchland Place on Fridays of each week from 7:00am to 5:00pm.

SECTION 2. City staff is directed to take all action necessary to implement this ordinance, including the installation of appropriate signage consistent with practices specified in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
