

**Ordinance #O-01-2023**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MONMOUTH BEACH  
COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY  
AMENDING CHAPTER II ENTITLED “ADMINISTRATION” SECTION 2-13.28  
ENTITLED “EXTRA DUTY ASSIGNMENTS FOR POLICE TRAFFIC SAFETY AND/OR  
SECURITY”**

*Chapter II Section 2-13.28 “Extra Duty assignments for police traffic safety and/or security” of the General Ordinances of the Borough of Monmouth Beach is hereby amended or supplemented as follows (new text is double underlined, text to be deleted is ~~struck through~~ and notations to the reader and changes in subparagraph designations either with or without changes to content are italicized):*

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Commissioners of the Borough of Monmouth Beach that Chapter II entitled “Administration”, Section 2-13.28 “Extra Duty assignments for police traffic safety and/or security” as follows:

**SECTION 1**

g. Rates for extra duty assignments; administrative charge. The rate for such services shall be the hourly overtime rate of a First-Class Patrolman without longevity as contained in the effective Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Borough of Monmouth Beach and New Jersey State Local PBA 332 in effect at the time the work is performed. In addition there shall be a charge for administrative costs at a rate of ~~\$7.50~~ \$8.50 per each hour worked by each Police Officer. This administrative cost is waived for the Monmouth Beach Board of Education.

**SECTION 2**

All Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to such inconsistency.

**SECTION 3**

If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance is adjudged to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to section paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

**SECTION 4**

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
