RESOLUTION RESCINDING THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE
OF THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:20-1.3a, on December 22, 2008, by Resolution 08-1168, the Monmouth County Board of County Commissioners, formerly identified as the Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders, adopted an Administrative Code organizing the administration of the County government, setting forth the duties and responsibilities and powers of all County officials and agencies, and the manner of performance needed; and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Code requires periodic review based on changes in the law and/or changes in County Government, requires changes and review due to the title "Freeholder" having changed to "Commissioner", and requires payment of annual fees for the publication of the Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Monmouth that the County hereby rescinds the Monmouth County Administrative Code, 2008, which was adopted by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:20-1.3c nothing in the previous Administrative Code shall change the duties or powers of County officers whose existence is mandated by the Constitution or shall diminish the duties, responsibilities or powers of those County offices.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that nothing in the previous Administrative Code shall in any way effect any statutory terms of County officials.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the rescission will be effective upon approval of this resolution by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Monmouth.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commissioner Director or his designee, and the Clerk of the Board are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the full intent and purpose of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk forward a certified true copy of this resolution to the County Administrator, County Counsel and all County Department and Division Heads.
