ORDINANCE NO. 1098-25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4-78 (CHAPTER 3 OF THE MURRYSVILLE CODE), AS AMENDED, TO EXPAND THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION TO NINE (9) MEMBERS.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 4-78 (Administrative Code), as amended, sets forth administrative regulations for the Municipality of Murrysville; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 4-78 (Administrative Code), as amended, defines the membership and terms for the Boards and Commissions of the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 303-91 expanded the membership of the Parks and Recreation Commission to seven (7) members; and

WHEREAS, Council of the Municipality of Murrysville desires to amend Ordinance No. 4-78 to enlarge the Parks and Recreation Commission to nine (9) members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MURRYSVILLE, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME AS FOLLOWS:

1) Change § 3-43 Membership and Terms to:

§ 3-43 Definitions.

- B. The Park Commission shall consist of nine individuals. Eight of such members shall be appointed by Council in accordance with the procedures set forth in § 3-37 of this code. The term of each member of the Commission shall be for three years or until his successor is appointed and qualified. The terms shall be staggered such that no less than two terms shall expire each year. In addition to the eight members appointed as described above, the School Board of the Franklin Regional Schools shall have the right to recommend annually to the Council for appointment to the Commission a duly elected or appointed member of the School Board or an employee of the Franklin Regional School District; provided, however, that any individual so recommended shall have been a resident of the Municipality for at least six months. Council shall appoint such individual to the Commission unless good cause is shown why such appointment shall not be made, in which event the School Board may recommend another qualified individual. Upon the failure of the School Board to recommend one of its qualified members for appointment, Council may appoint any resident of the Municipality for the one-year term, or remainder thereof,

in accordance with § 3-37 of this code. No member of the Commission shall receive any compensation for his services, but he shall be reimbursed for reasonable expenses actually and necessarily incurred in the performance of his duties.
