



ORDINANCE

PROHIBITING PARKING ON A PORTION OF THE NORTH SIDE OF AMHERST STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Twenty-Two

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-68 “No parking or standing on certain streets and no on-street student drop-off or pick-up on certain streets” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language in alphabetical order as follows:

“§ 320-68. No parking or stopping on certain streets and no on-street student drop-off or pick-up on certain streets.

A. No parking or stopping of any vehicle shall be permitted on the following streets:

Name of Street	Side	Location
<u>Amherst Street</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>From the east side of the driveway to 485 Amherst Street easterly to a point 200 feet east of the driveway to 471 Amherst Street</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s) and/or pavement markings.
