



ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING FEES FOR PARKING SPACES UTILIZED FOR EXTENDED OUTDOOR DINING

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Twenty-Two

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XI “Parking Meters”, Section 320-47 “Parking meter and reserved space fees; permits; meter bags”, subsection F of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined language and deleting the struck through language:

“§ 320-47. Parking meter and reserved space fees; permits; meter bags.

...

F. ~~(Reserved)~~ There shall be a \$500 fee for each on-street parking space which is eliminated due to an approved extended outdoor dining permit. The fee will not apply to on-street parking spaces that are used for the tapering of traffic barriers. The total fee due shall be payable at the time of the submittal of an Extended Outdoor Dining Worksheet. The fee for each space covers one extended outdoor dining season. This section shall be in effect for the 2023 outdoor dining season, May 1, 2023 through October 15, 2023.”

During 2023, this section supersedes any inconsistent ordinances or parts of ordinances.

This ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
