



ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF STOP SIGNS AT THE SOUTHEAST AND SOUTHWEST CORNERS OF PARRISH HILL DRIVE AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH PARRISH HILL DRIVE

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Twenty-Three

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article III “Stop and Yield Intersections”, Section 320-4 “Stop intersections”, subsection D of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language as follows:

“§ 320-4. Stop intersections.

...

- D. The following intersections are hereby designated as stop or through streets, and authority is hereby granted for the erection of a stop sign at the corner so designated in accordance with the tenor of this chapter:

Stop Sign on	Sign Location	At Intersection of
...		
Parrish Hill Drive	Southeast corner	Parrish Hill Drive
Parrish Hill Drive	Southwest corner	Parrish Hill Drive”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s) and/or device(s).
