



ORDINANCE

DESIGNATING THE JOYCE PARK WILDLIFE SANCTUARY AS CITY CONSERVATION LAND

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Twenty-Three

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II "General Legislation", Chapter 215 "Parks and Recreation Areas", Article III "Conservation Lands", Section 215-9 "Conservation lands designated" of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 215-9. Conservation lands designated.

- A. The following lands are hereby designated conservation lands of the City of Nashua:
 - (1) The Northwest Sanctuary.
 - (2) The Southwest Conservation Area.
 - (3) Joyce Park Wildlife Sanctuary.
- B. Any appropriate mappings or descriptions of such lands are incorporated by reference.
- C. Additional conservation areas shall be designated by amendment to this section.”

A map identifying the Joyce Park Wildlife Sanctuary is attached.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
