



## ORDINANCE

### AUTHORIZING TRAFFIC AND PARKING CHANGES ON WATER STREET

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Twenty-Three*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order, deleting the struck-through language, and renumbering when appropriate:

1. In Article III “Stop and Yield Intersections”, Section 320-4 “Stop intersections”, subsection D:

**“§ 320-4. Stop intersections.**

...

- D. The following intersections are hereby designated as stop or through streets, and authority is hereby granted for the erection of a stop sign at the corner so designated in accordance with the tenor of this chapter:

<u>Mechanic Street</u>	<u>Southeast corner</u>	<u>Water Street</u>
<u>Mechanic Street parking lot, south exit</u>	<u>Southeast corner</u>	<u>Water Street</u>
Water Street	Northeast <u>and northwest</u> corners	Factory Street”

- 2. In Article III “Stop and Yield Intersections”, Section 320-5 “Yield intersections”, subsection C:

**“§ 320-5. Yield intersections.**

...

- C. The following shall be yield intersections:

- 3. In Article IV “Turning movements”, Section 320-13 “Left turn prohibited at all times”:

**“§ 320-13. Left turn prohibited at all times.**

- A. Left turns shall be prohibited at all times at the following intersections:

- 4. In Article IV “Turning movements”, add a new Section 320-14.1 “Right turn prohibited at all times”:

**“§ 320-14.1 Right turn prohibited at all times.**

Right turns shall be prohibited at all times at the following intersections:

5. In Article VII “One-Way Streets”, Section 320-27 “One-way streets at all times”:

**“§ 320-27. One-way streets at all times.**

The following streets are hereby designated as one-way streets:

Name of Street	Direction of Travel	Location

<u>Water Street</u>	<u>Southwesterly</u>	<u>From Main Street to Factory Street</u>

6. In Article XII “Parking Time Limits in Non-Parking-Lot Areas”, Section 320-35 Fifteen-minute parking”:

**“§ 320-35. Fifteen-minute parking.**

A. No vehicle shall be stationed or remain for a period exceeding 15 minutes on the following streets:

Name of Street	Side	Location
<u>Water Street</u>	<u>South</u>	<u>Beginning 185 feet east of Mechanic Street to a point 228 feet east of Mechanic Street</u>

7. In Article XI “Parking Meters”, Section 320-48 “Parking meter lots”:

**“§ 320-48. Parking meter lots.**

The following described areas lying within the corporate limits of the City are designated as public parking areas and shall constitute parking meter lots in the listed zones:

A. Zone II.

...

(2) — ~~Le Parc de Notre Renaissance Francaise parking lot.~~”

8. In Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-69 “No parking on certain streets”:

**“§ 320-69. No parking on certain streets.**

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Location</b>

Water Street and Water Street Ramp	North	From <del>Main Street</del> to Factory Street a distance of 360 feet easterly towards <u>Main Street</u>
Water Street and Water Street Ramp	South	From Factory Street to <del>Mechanic Street</del> a distance of 155 feet easterly towards <u>Main Street</u>
Water Street and Water Street Ramp	South	From Mechanic Street a distance of <del>127</del> <u>185</u> feet easterly towards Main Street and from Main Street a distance of <del>100</del> <u>40</u> feet westerly towards Mechanic Street”

9. In Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-71 “Loading zones”:

**“§ 320-71. Loading zones.**

...

- B. The following areas are designated as loading zones, and no parking shall be permitted therein between 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday, and no vehicle utilizing these loading zones shall be stationed or remain for a period exceeding one hour:

Water Street	North	From the entrance to Le Parc de Notre Renaissance Francaise easterly for a distance of <del>40 feet</del> <u>Beginning 30 feet west of Main Street and extending westerly 55 feet”</u>

10. In Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-72 “Handicapped parking”:

**“§ 320-72. Handicapped parking.**

...

A. The following parking spaces are designated as spaces for the handicapped:

Name of Street	Number of Spaces/ Type	Location
...		
Water Street	<u>1/parallel</u> <u>1 head-in</u>	<del>South side, starting 115 feet east of Mechanic Street and extending easterly to a point 135 feet east of Mechanic Street</del> <u>North side, east of Mechanic Street”</u>

11. In Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-75 “Parking limited in certain City parking lots”:

**“§ 320-75. Parking limited in certain City parking lots.**

...

~~B. Le Parc de Notre Renaissance Francaise. No vehicle may be parked in the southwest parcel of Le Parc de Notre Renaissance Francaise parking lot (25 Water Street; southwest of Mechanic Street) between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Sundays between June 1 and October 31. During this time period, vehicles may exit the easterly portion of the lot by means of the easterly driveway.”~~

12. In Article XIV “Manner of Parking”, Section 320-80 “Forty-five-degree angle”:

**“§ 320-80. Forty-five-degree angle.**

On the following streets, every vehicle remaining in any one place thereon shall be parked at an angle of 45 degrees, with the right front wheel to the curb:

<u>Water Street</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 125 feet east of Mechanic Street and extending westerly to a point 5 feet east of Mechanic Street”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the completion of construction and the time of removal and installation of the appropriate sign(s).
