



ORDINANCE

INCREASING THE COMPENSATION FOR CERTAIN BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Twenty-Four

The City of Nashua ordains that the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language and deleting the struck-through language as shown:

1. In Part I “Administrative Legislation”, Chapter 5 “Administration of Government”, Part 2 “Board of Aldermen”, Article II “General Provisions”, Section 5-6 “Compensation”, subsection A:

“§ 5-6. Compensation.

- A. Each Alderman shall receive as compensation the sum of \$5,000 per year, payable quarterly. Starting on July 1, 2024, each alderman shall receive as compensation the sum of \$9,000 per year, payable quarterly. On July 1 of each following year, the compensation of each alderman shall change by a factor equal to the average of the changes in the Consumer Price Index—Urban (CPI-U) of the preceding three calendar years as published by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

2. In Part I “Administrative Legislation”, Chapter 5 “Administration of Government”, Part 6 “Board of Education and Board of Public Works”, Article XX “Board of Education”, Section 5-109 “Compensation of members”:

“§ 5-109. Compensation of members.

- A. Each member of the Board of Education shall receive as compensation the sum of \$4,000 per year, payable quarterly. Starting on July 1, 2024, each member of the Board of Education shall receive as compensation the sum of \$7,200 per year, payable quarterly. On July 1 of each following year, the compensation of each member of the Board of Education shall change by a factor equal to the average of the changes in the Consumer Price Index—Urban (CPI-U) of the preceding three calendar years as published by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

3. In Part I “Administrative Legislation”, Chapter 5 “Administration of Government”, Part 6 “Board of Education and Board of Public Works”, Article XXI “Board of Public Works”, Section 5-110 “Compensation”:

“§ 5-110. Compensation.

Each member of the Board of Public Works, exclusive of the Mayor, shall receive as compensation the sum of \$2,000 per year, payable quarterly. Starting on July 1, 2024, each member of the Board of Public Works, exclusive of the Mayor, shall receive as compensation the sum of \$3,600 per year, payable quarterly. On July 1 of each following year, the compensation of each member of the Board of Public Works, exclusive of the Mayor, shall change by a factor equal to the average of the changes in the Consumer Price Index—Urban (CPI-U) of the preceding three calendar years as published by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.”

4. In Part I “Administrative Legislation”, Chapter 5 “Administration of Government”, Part 6 “Board of Education and Board of Public Works”, amend the title of Part 6 as shown and add the following new Article and Section:

“Part 6

Board of Education, ~~and Board of Public Works,~~ and Board of Health

ARTICLE XXI½

Board of Health

§ 5-112.5. Compensation.

Each member of the Board of Health shall receive as compensation the sum of \$1,070 per year, payable quarterly. Starting on July 1, 2024, each member of the Board of Health shall receive as compensation the sum of \$2,000 per year, payable quarterly. On July 1 of each following year, the compensation of each member of the Board of Health shall change by a factor equal to the average of the changes in the Consumer Price Index—Urban (CPI-U) of the preceding three calendar years as published by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.”

5. In Part I “Administrative Legislation”, Chapter 5 “Administration of Government”, Part 7 “Taxation and Finance”, Article XXIII “Board of Assessors”, Section 5-120 “Compensation”:

“§ 5-120. Compensation.

Each member of the Board of Assessors shall serve on a part-time basis and all salaries shall be paid monthly. For Fiscal Year 2024, each member of the Board of Assessors shall be paid for his or her services as determined and approved by the Board of Aldermen through the annual budget process, which was that each member of the Board of Assessors shall receive as compensation the sum of \$1,500 per year. All salaries

~~shall be paid monthly.~~ Starting on July 1, 2024, each member of the Board of Assessors shall receive as compensation the sum of \$2,700 per year, payable quarterly. On July 1 of each following year, the compensation of each member of the Board of Assessors shall change by a factor equal to the average of the changes in the Consumer Price Index—Urban (CPI-U) of the preceding three calendar years as published by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.”

6. In Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 23 “Elections and Campaigns”, Article I “General Voting Procedures”, Section 23-5 “Compensation of Board of Voter Registrars”:

“§ 23-5. Compensation of Board of Voter Registrars.

The members of the Board of Voter Registrars shall be paid in full for their services in the following amounts, and at such times as hereinafter specified: the Clerk of such board shall receive annually \$400, the other two members each \$300 annually, all payable quarterly. Starting on July 1, 2024, the Clerk of the Board of Voter Registrars shall receive as compensation the sum of \$800 per year, payable quarterly, and the other two members of the Board of Voter Registrars shall receive as compensation the sum of \$600 per year, payable quarterly. On July 1 of each following year, the compensation of each member of the Board of Voter Registrars shall change by a factor equal to the average of the changes in the Consumer Price Index—Urban (CPI-U) of the preceding three calendar years as published by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.”

7. In Part II “General Legislation, Chapter 156 “Fire Prevention”, Article III “Fire Department”, Section 156-4 “Compensation of Commissioners”:

“§ 156-4. Compensation of Commissioners.

Each City Fire Commissioner shall receive as compensation the sum of \$1,500 per year, payable quarterly. Starting on July 1, 2024, each City Fire Commissioner shall receive as compensation the sum of \$2,700 per year, payable quarterly. On July 1 of each following year, the compensation of each City Fire Commissioner shall change by a factor equal to the average of the changes in the Consumer Price Index—Urban (CPI-U) of the preceding three calendar years as published by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.”
