



ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING THE SCHOOL STREET PARKING GARAGE

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Twenty-Four

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the construction of the Flats on High Street apartment community at 44 High Street, Nashua, 48 parking spaces were constructed in a garage at grade beneath the apartments. These spaces were constructed to serve the general public and are in a climate-controlled garage.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XI “Parking Meters”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended as follows:

1. In Section 320-47 “Parking meter and reserved space fees; permits; meter bags”, by adding the following new underlined language:

“§ 320-47. Parking meter and reserved space fees; permits; meter bags.

A. The parking fee for all public metered parking lots, garages and metered on-street parking shall be as follows:

...

(4) In Zone IV, \$2.00 per hour for the first three (3) hours, \$4.00 per hour for the fourth (4th) hour and thereafter until the vehicle leaves the space.”

2. In Section 320-48 “Parking meter lots”, by adding the following new underlined language:

“§ 320-48 Parking meter lots.

...

C. Zone IV.

(1) The School Street parking garage.”

3. In Section 320-49 “Time limits in parking lots”, by adding the following new underlined language:

“§ 320-49 Time limits in parking lots.

A. Time limits in parking lots shall be as follows

...

(3) In Zone IV, twenty-four (24) hours a day, daily, including Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, with no time limit.”

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
