



## ORDINANCE

### AUTHORIZING A SCHOOL SAFETY ZONE AND TWO SCHOOL ZONE FLASHING SPEED LIMIT SIGNS ON BUCKMEADOW ROAD

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Twenty-Four*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article VI “Speed Limits”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

1. In Section 320-24 “School safety zones”:

**“§ 320-24. School safety zones.**

The following streets and parts of streets are hereby established as school safety zones, and a speed limit of 20 miles per hour is hereby established in such zones and will be enforced during school opening, closing or recess:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Location</b>

<u>Buckmeadow Road</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 1,000 feet northwest of DiAntonio Drive and extending to a point 500 feet southeast of DiAntonio Drive”</u>

2. In Section 320-26 “School speed limits when flashing”:

**“§ 320-26. School speed limits when flashing.**

At the following school safety zones, flashing speed limit signs shall be installed, at a location to be determined by the Department of Streets. Such safety zones are as follows:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Location</b>
...	
<u>Buckmeadow Road</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 1,000 feet northwest of DiAntonio Drive and extending to a point 500 feet southeast of DiAntonio Drive”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s) and/or device(s).
