



## ORDINANCE

### AMENDING THE LOCATION OF THE DALIANIS HOUSE RESERVED PARKING SPACES DUE TO CONSTRUCTION

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Twenty-Four*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XI “Parking Meters”, Section 320-47 “Parking meter and reserved space fees; permits; meter bags”, subsection E (2) of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined language:

**“§ 320-47. Parking meter and reserved space fees; permits; meter bags.**

E. Upon authorization by the Infrastructure Committee, the City may lease parking lots or spaces to non-City entities at a rate approved by the Infrastructure Committee. In addition, the City has authorized the following:

...

- (2) Dalianis House may obtain up to eight prepaid yearly parking permits for one of the metered parking spaces under the Water Street Bridge for \$10 per permit per year for residents of Dalianis House. During the period of time when these metered parking spaces under the Water Street Bridge are not available due to construction in Water Street, Le Parc de Notre Renaissance Francaise, and Le Parc de Notre Renaissance Francaise Parking Lot, up to eight metered parking spaces on Factory Street, at locations to be determined by the Parking Manager, may be used instead. The daily time limit for which these reserved parking spaces are leased shall be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily. The reserved parking space regulations shall not apply on Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays.”

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
