ARTICLE ONE: The Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Naples finds that parking on Dumond Street has the potential for restricting prompt and safe access of emergency vehicles to properties located on said street and further has created an unsafe condition for vehicular passage on the street. Therefore in order to protect and promote public safety, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Naples hereby enacts this Local Law.

ARTICLE TWO: See the attached Schedule A for the text of this Local Law.

ARTICLE THREE: This Local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State.
