SECTION 1. TITLE

This Local Law shall be referred to as "A Local Law Amending Section 280-8(A) of Chapter 280 of the Town Code of the Town of New Windsor, entitled 'Vehicles and Traffic'".

SECTION 2. AUTHORITY

This Local Law is enacted pursuant to Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law. This Local Law shall supersede the provisions of Town Law to the extent it is inconsistent with the same, and to the extent permitted by the New York State Constitution, the Municipal Home Rule Law, or any other applicable statute.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE AND FINDINGS

The purpose of this Local Law is to amend Chapter 280 of the Town Code of the Town of New Windsor in order to reflect the Town's desire to further ensure the safety of all those that travel and traverse upon or near certain Town owned roadways, listed in Section 4 below, by clarifying the area of no parking at the location listed in Section 4 below.

SECTION 4. AMENDMENT TO SECTION 280-8(A) OF CHAPTER 280 OF THE TOWN CODE OF THE TOWN OF NEW WINDSOR.

Section 280-8(A) of the Vehicles and Traffic Law of the Town of New Windsor, prohibits the parking of vehicles on certain designated streets. Section 280-8(A) is hereby amended as follows:

(88) Hudson Valley Avenue: No parking along the westerly shoulder of Hudson Valley Avenue, commencing at the southerly-most entrance of 500 Hudson Valley Avenue and continuing in a northerly direction for a distance of 550 feet to the northerly-most driveway of 500 Hudson Valley Avenue.

(89) Hudson Valley Avenue: No parking along the easterly and westerly shoulders of Hudson Valley Avenue, commencing at the northerly-most entrance to 500 Hudson Valley Avenue and continuing, on both the easterly and westerly shoulders of Hudson Valley Avenue, for a distance of 1,000 feet and terminating at the intersection with Hawthorne Way.

(90) Avenue of the Americas: No parking along the northerly and southerly shoulders of Avenue of the Americas, commencing at the intersection with Hudson Valley Avenue and continuing, on both the northerly and southerly shoulders, for a distance of 2,200 feet to the intersection with Bill Larkin Drive.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.

If any word, phrase, sentence, part, section, subsection, or other portion of this law, or any application thereof to any person or circumstance, is declared void, unconstitutional, or invalid for any reason, then such word, phrase, sentence, part, section, subsection, or other portion, or the proscribed application thereof, shall be severable, and the remaining provisions of this law, and all applications thereof, not having been declared void, unconstitutional, or invalid, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. CONFLICT WITH OTHER LAWS.

Where this law differs or conflicts with other laws, rules and regulations, unless the right to do so is preempted or prohibited by the County, State or Federal government, the more restrictive or protective of the Town and the public shall apply.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This law shall become effective upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State.
