

ORDINANCE 2024:19

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER XIX, "PARKS AND RECREATION," OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW MILFORD, TO ESTABLISH RULES FOR TENNIS/PICKLEBALL COURTS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Milford, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 19, entitled "Parks and Recreation," of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of New Milford, is hereby amended to add thereto Section 19-2B to read in full as follows:

§19-2B Tennis/Pickleball Courts.

Rules and regulations governing the use of the tennis/pickleball courts located at Baeli Park (Block 1402, Lot 23) and the Kennedy Field Sports Complex (Block 301, Lot 2) shall be as follows:

- a. Courts are for tennis and/or pickleball only.
- b. Skateboards, rollerblades, bicycles, etc. are not permitted.
- c. When others are waiting, play time is limited to one (1) hour.
- d. Open play only, organized activities require a permit.
- e. No person shall alter the tennis/pickleball courts' surfaces with tape, paint, chalk or any other product.
- f. No pets shall be permitted on the tennis/pickleball courts.
- g. No chairs or other obstructions shall be permitted on the tennis/pickleball courts.
- h. No temporary nets or netting shall be permitted on the tennis/pickleball courts.
- i. The tennis/pickleball courts shall be restricted to residents and their guests only. A resident may have a maximum of three (3) guests at any one time who must occupy the same court as the resident.
- j. Identification must be presented upon request by a borough employee.
- k. Gates are to be locked at all times when not in use.
- l. Except as modified herein, the rules and regulations set forth in Section 19-2 hereof shall be applicable to the tennis/pickleball courts.

Section 2. Any ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith any are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. In case any clause, sentence, section or other provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or repeal the remainder of this ordinance except insofar as the clause, sentence, section or other provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder thereof.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
