

**ORDINANCE NO. 2026:13**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW MILFORD ENTITLED “TRAFFIC” THEREBY AMENDING SECTION 7-3.6, “PARKING PROHIBITED CERTAIN HOURS FOR STREET CLEANING AND SNOW REMOVAL**

**WHEREAS**, §3-11.4, Parking Prohibition, of Chapter 3, Police Regulation, of the Code of the Borough of New Milford prohibits the parking of any vehicle upon any street within the Borough when snow covers the street and provides that any vehicle parked in violation thereof may be removed; and

**WHEREAS**, §7-3.6, Parking Prohibited Certain Hour for Street Cleaning and Snow Removal, of Chapter 7, Traffic, of the Code of the Borough of New Milford prohibits the parking and standing of vehicles on certain streets during certain hours for street cleaning and snow removal purposes but does not specifically authorize the removal of such vehicles parking or standing in violation thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council find that it is in the best interest of the residents of New Milford to include a provision for the removal of vehicles parked or standing in violation of §7-3.6; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Milford, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1.** §7-3.6, Parking Prohibited Certain Hours for Street Cleaning and Snow Removal, of Chapter 7, Traffic, of the Code of the Borough of New Milford is hereby amended to read in full as follows:

**§ 7-3.6. Parking Prohibited Certain Hours for Street Cleaning and Snow Removal.**

- a. For street cleaning purposes and snow removal, there shall be no parking or standing on the following streets, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. on the days specified, except for legal holidays, and excluding U.S. Postal Service vehicles while in the performance of their official duties.

Bulger Avenue [Ord. No. 2023:17]	South	Tuesday	From the Boulevard east to a point 525 feet.
Faller Drive	North	Wednesday	From east side of the traffic circle to Hoffman Avenue.
Faller Drive	North	Wednesday	From River Road north to the traffic circle.
Pacific Street	East	Friday	From Reichelt Road north to the traffic circle.
Reichelt Road	North	Thursday	From River Road east to Boulevard.
South Plympton Street	East	Thursday	From Reichelt Road south to East Woodland Road.

- b. Removal of Vehicles by Borough. Any unoccupied vehicle parked or standing in violation of subsection **7-3.6a** shall be deemed a nuisance and menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic, and the Police Department or Department of Public Works may provide for the removal of such vehicle. The owner shall pay the costs of the removal and storage of the vehicle, not in excess of rates permitted by Chapter **4**, subsection **4-15.16** entitled "Rates" before regaining possession of the vehicle.
- c. Violations and Penalties. Any person convicted of a violation of a provision of this subsection, or any supplement thereto, shall be liable to a penalty of \$55 for each day of occurrence.

## **SECTION 2. Severability**

If any provision of this Ordinance, or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstances, shall be held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance to the extent it can be given effect, or the application of such provision to persons or circumstances other than

those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby, and to this extent the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

**SECTION 3. Inconsistency**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to the extent of such inconsistencies.

**SECTION 4. Effective Date**

This ordinance shall become effective immediately following final adoption and publication thereof as required by law.
