### Local Law No. 1 of the year 2023

# Town of New Berlin A Local Law to Authorize the Town Highway Superintendent to Reside within a town that borders the Town of New Berlin

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Town Board of the Town of New Berlin, Chenango County, New York, as follows:

### **SECTION 1.**

The duly appointed Town Highway superintendent of the Town of New Berlin may reside within any Town that borders the Town of New Berlin.

### **SECTION 2.**

The provision of this new local law supersedes Section 4 of Local law #7 of 1995 as it relates to the residency requirements of the Highway Superintendent

#### **SECTION 3.**

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York, in accordance with the applicable provisions of law, and specifically Article 3, Section 27 of the New York State Municipal Home Rule Law.
