LOCAL LAW # 2 OF 2021

TOWN OF NEW BERLIN A LOCAL LAW TO PROHIBIT THROWING SNOW INTO PUBLIC STREETS OR SIDEWALKS

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of New Berlin as follows:

Section 1. This Local law will repeal and replace Local Law #3 of 2017

Section 2. No person shall throw, cast, blow, push or place or cause to be thrown, cast, blown, pushed or placed any snow, ice or sleet into any public street, place or sidewalk within the Town.

Section 3. Any person who violates any provision of this local law shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$ 50.00, for the first conviction. For a second conviction within five years the fine shall not exceed \$ 150.00. For a third or subsequent conviction within five years, the fine shall not exceed \$250.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State.
