

BILL NO. 1110ORDINANCE NO. 1095

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI AMENDING SECTION 16-2,
DEFINITIONS, MOTOR VEHICLES IN TRAFFIC, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO

WHEREAS, on June 20, 1980 the Governor of the State of Missouri signed into law House Bills No. 995 and 1051 defining and regulating the use of motorized bicycles (mopeds), and

WHEREAS, these bills contained an emergency clause becoming effective immediately upon the signature of the Governor, and

WHEREAS, the new laws specifically excluded motorized bicycles or mopeds from the definition of "vehicle" or "motor vehicle" under the statutes of the State of Missouri and

WHEREAS, the manager of the motor vehicle bureau of the State of Missouri has determined that the motorcycle helmet law does not apply to such motorized bicycles since they are excluded from the definition of vehicles or motor vehicles, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Neosho, Missouri is desirous of bringing the Code of Ordinances of the City of Neosho into correlation with the Revised Statutes of Missouri,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

That Article 1, Section 16-2. Definition, "Motor Vehicle" is hereby amended to read as follows:

" Any self-propelled vehicle not operated exclusively on tracks, except farm tractors, and except any two wheeled or three wheeled device having full operative pedals capable of propulsion by human power, an automatic transmission and a motor with a cylinder capacity of not more than fifty cubic centimeters, which produces less than two gross brake horsepower, and is capable of propelling the device at a maximum speed of not more than 30 miles per hour on level ground."

All other ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after

final passage and approval.
