

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI, CREATING AND ADDING TO CHAPTER 350 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI, DESIGNATING PARKING OF LARGE TRUCKS, TRACTORS OR TRAILERS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Chapter 350 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Neosho, Missouri is hereby amended to reflect the following parking regulations.

Parking of large trucks, tractors or trailers.

No person shall park a truck, tractor or trailer with a capacity larger than 18,000 pounds on any residential street, drive, court, avenue, terrace or boulevard within the corporate city limits of the City of Neosho, except while loading or unloading. No person shall park such truck, tractor, or trailer upon any real property so as to obscure the vision of an operator of a motor vehicle who is operating said vehicle upon a city roadway, street, drive, court, avenue, terrace or boulevard within the immediate location of said parked truck, tractor or trailer, except while loading or unloading. No person shall use any street for the purpose of repairing or reconditioning any such truck, tractor or trailer, or any part thereof, except when such repairs are necessitated by an emergency.

Section 2: The provisions of this ordinance shall be included and incorporated in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Neosho, Missouri, as an addition or amendment thereto, and shall be appropriately renumbered to conform to the uniform numbering system of the Code.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect fifteen (15) days after final passage and approval.
