

BILL NO. 554ORDINANCE NO. 540

THE SAME BEING AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 344 OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO AND PROVIDING A NEW SECTION FOR SAID ORDINANCE REQUIRING SEPARATE PREMISES RECEIVING WATER FROM THE CITY OF NEOSHO TO BE SEPARATELY METERED; AND FURTHER AMENDING SAID ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE THAT METER DEPOSIT FOR RESIDENTIAL METERS INSTALLED IN THE FUTURE SHALL BE TEN DOLLAR (\$10.00) IN LIEU OF FIVE DOLLARS (\$5.00) AS NOW PROVIDED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: Ordinance No. 344 of the City of Neosho, Missouri is hereby amended so as to add the following paragraph to Section 7 of said ordinance:

"Separate premises must have separate service pipe installation, curb stops and curb boxes and be separately metered. In no case shall a consumer extend a service pipe or plumbing across a street or alley or to adjacent property in order to furnish service to such adjacent property even though such adjacent property be owned by the same party.

Where water is to be supplied to several parties in apartments, offices or stores all located in a single building and supplied through one service the City of Neosho will contract with only one party and he shall be responsible to the city for the payment of water bills."

Section Two: Ordinance No. 344 of the City of Neosho is further amended so as to provide the following new section:

"Section No. IIa.: Meter deposits for residential meters installed from and after this date shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00) provided, however, that in those instances where such residential user already has a Five Dollar (\$5.00) meter deposit and desires to transfer the same to a new location such transfer shall be permitted without the deposit of an additional Five Dollars (\$5.00).

Section Three: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section Four: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval.
