

BILL NO. 605ORDINANCE NO. 591

THE SAME BEING AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO AMENDING EXISTING ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO SO AS TO PROVIDE TWO NEW SECTIONS, BEING SECTION 6-11 AND 6-12 TO CHAPTER SIX OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, PROHIBITING ACTS OF VANDALISM TO THE NEOSHO MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE AND FURTHER PROVIDING THAT ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO SHALL APPLY TO ANY PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF NEOSHO BEING USED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES, WHETHER THE SAME LIES WITHIN OR WITHOUT THE CITY LIMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Chapter Six of the ordinances of the City of Neosho is hereby amended so as to provide a new Section 6-11 and a new Section 6-12 thereto, to read as follows:

"Section 6-11: No person or persons shall dig into, tear up or drive upon the sodded turf of the grass greens of the Neosho Municipal Golf Course, nor shall any person or persons drive upon the fairways of the Neosho Municipal Golf Course except in motorized or self-propelled golf cars or carts as may be approved by the golf course committee.

Section 6-12: All ordinances of the City of Neosho shall be effective as to any property owned by the City of Neosho and being used for any lawful municipal purpose, whether or not said property lies within or without the city limits of the City of Neosho, including but not to the exclusion of any not mentioned, the swimming pool, industrial park, municipal golf course, Neosho Memorial Airport and adjacent areas thereto."

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage and approval.
