AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI, AMENDING CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE III, SECTION 12-44. LITTERING ON PUBLIC PROPERTY. OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 12, Article III, Section 12-44. Littering on Public Property. of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Neosho, Missouri, be hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Enacted in its place as Section 12-44 shall be the following Ordinance, to-wit:

"SECTION 12-44. Prohibited on Public Property.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to litter, dump or throw cans, paper, straw, sawdust, boxes, glass, metal vessels or containers, iron, clothes, bottles, filth, offal, trash, rubbish, garbage or other materials on public rights-of-way, public square, alleys, sidewalks, parks, or any of the water-ways in the City or adjoining grounds.

(b) There shall be a rebuttable presumption that any person whose name appears, as an addressee with a postmark, on any unlawfully disposed of litter, as defined above, shall be deemed the person who unlawfully disposed of said litter."

(c) A violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not less than \$100.00 nor to exceed \$500.00 or a jail sentence not to exceed three (3) months or by both such fines and jail sentence.
