

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI, REPEALING SECTION 4-24 TO MINORS; PROVISIO OF ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 4, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI AND ENACTING A NEW SECTION 4-24 SALE OR SUPPLY OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO MINORS OF ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 4, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI:

SECTION 4-24. Sale or supply of alcoholic beverages to minors.

Intoxicating liquor, malt liquor, or non-intoxicating beer, as defined in Section 4-1 of this Chapter shall not be given, sold, or otherwise supplied to any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years.

- (1) For purposes of prosecution, there shall be a rebuttable presumption that any sealed or unopened can or container which by its label purports to be an intoxicating liquor, malt liquor, or non-intoxicating beer shall be as stated on its label.
- (2) This Ordinance shall not apply to supplying of intoxicating liquor, malt liquor, or non-intoxicating beer to a person under such age for medicinal purposes only, or by the parent or guardian of such person, or to administering of such intoxicating liquor to such person by a physician.
