

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI, AMENDING SECTION 9-1 OF ARTICLE I. OF CHAPTER 9 ELECTRICITY OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI TO UPDATE FROM THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, 1987 EDITION TO THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, 1993 EDITION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI:

SECTION I

ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL. CHAPTER 9. ELECTRICITY. SECTION 9-1.

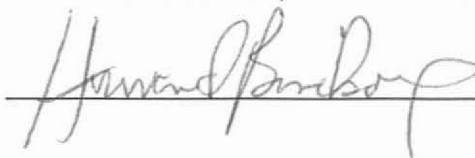
There is hereby adopted by the City, for the purpose of establishing rules and regulations for the installation and maintenance of electric conductors and equipment within or on public and private buildings or other structures; including mobile home, recreational vehicles, and floating buildings; and other premises such as yards, carnival, parking and other lots, and industrial substations, contained in the National Electrical Code, 1993 edition, being the official regulations of the National Fire Protection Association for electrical wiring and apparatus, and the whole thereof, except as modified by this chapter, of which a copy has been and is now filed in the office of the City Clerk and the same is hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein, and from the date on which this section shall take effect, the provisions thereof shall be controlling in the installation and use of electrical wiring and apparatus therein contained within the corporate limits of the city, except as otherwise provided by this chapter.

SECTION III

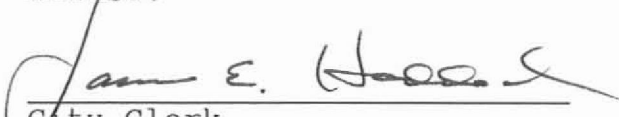
All ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

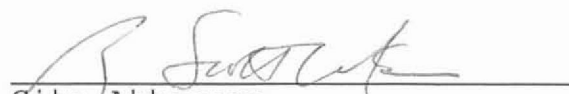
