

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 17 OF THE NEOSHO CITY CODE, MUNICIPAL COURT, BY AMENDING SECTION 17-29 TO PROVIDE FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF AN ADDITIONAL \$1.00 AS COURT COSTS TO PROVIDE A CREDIT TO THE PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING COMMISSION FUND.

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 268 passed by the 87th General Assembly provides that an additional \$1.00 may be assessed as costs and sent to the State Treasury to the credit of the Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission Fund and any municipality not contributing to said fund shall not be entitled to reimbursement from said fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI:

SECTION I

That Chapter 17 of the Neosho City Code, Municipal Court, be, and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 17-29 to add a new sub-paragraph "(f)" to provide for the assessment of an additional \$1.00 as court costs for credit to the Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission Fund, so that amended Section 17-29 shall read as follows:

Section 17-29. Court Costs: Costs for training police officers.

(a) Costs of court in the amount of five dollars (\$5.00) shall be assessed as court costs, except there shall be no costs in overtime parking cases.

(b) In all cases of moving traffic violations costs for the training of police officers in the amount of two dollars (\$2.00).

(c) Other costs such as for the issuance of a warrant, a commitment, summons, and witness fees, as provided before the associate circuit judge in criminal prosecutions.

(d) Actual costs assessed against the city by the county sheriff for apprehension or confinement in the county jail.

(e) Mileage, in the same amount as provided to the sheriff in criminal violations for each mile and fraction thereof the officer must travel (both directions) in order to serve any warrant or commitment or order of this court.

(f) An additional \$1.00 shall be assessed as costs in all cases except those for non-moving traffic violations, and such additional \$1.00 shall be sent to the State Treasury to the credit of the Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission Fund pursuant to Section 590.110 RSMo (1993).

SECTION II

All ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect 15 days after final passage and approval.
