

THE SAME BEING AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI, CANVASSING THE ELECTION RETURNS OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 3, 1998, SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID CITY A PROPOSITION TO IMPOSE A 3/8 OF ONE PERCENT TRANSPORTATION SALES TAX AND DECLARING THE RESULTS THEREOF UNDER EMERGENCY MEASURE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: It is found and determined that on February 3, 1998, the City of Neosho held and conducted a valid and proper Municipal Election for the purpose of voting upon the following:

"PROPOSITION"

"Shall the City of Neosho, Missouri, impose a sales tax of 3/8 of one percent for transportation purposes?"

and that the County Clerk did certify the results within the appropriate time frame to the Neosho City Council.

That after due and proper canvass of said returns, the following are declared to be the official votes:

That said proposition having received 367 votes for and 167 votes against, it is found and determined that said proposition received a majority of the votes of the qualified voters of said election on said proposition.

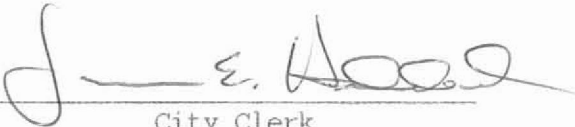
SECTION 2: It is further found, declared, and determined that notice of said election was duly given and published in the manner provided by law, and that said election was held and conducted in all respects in conformity with the Constitution and Laws of the State of Missouri.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is passed as an emergency measure due to the requirement of providing the Department of Revenue of the State of Missouri a certified copy of the ordinance extending the tax, copy of the ballot, and the certified results immediately following the election. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and final approval.
