

AN ORDINANCE REVISING BY AMENDMENT CHAPTER 210 SECTION 250, "LICENSES TO BE OBTAINED FROM CITY COLLECTOR" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF NEOSHO, BY EXPANDING THE PERSON(S) AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE LICENSES TO INCLUDE LOCALLY AUTHORIZED VETERINARIANS AND RENAMING SAID SECTION TO "LICENSES".

Whereas, Section 210.250 of the Neosho Code of Ordinances currently authorizes the City Collector to issue animal licenses upon presentation of a certification of vaccination as described in Section 210.240, and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Neosho has addressed the lack of current licensing of pets within the City of Neosho, and the need of greater accountability of citizens in regards to their dog(s) and/or cat(s), and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Neosho recognizing the difficulty of obtaining said animal license during normal business hours deem it is proper to allow for the issuance of licenses by locally authorized veterinarians subsequent to said veterinarian's proper vaccination of the citizen's dog(s) and/or cat(s) and issuance of certificate of vaccination,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 210.250 shall be amended to the following language: Section 210.250: Licenses

Licenses issued pursuant to this Article may be obtained from the City Collector upon presentation of the certificate of vaccination described in Section 210.240.

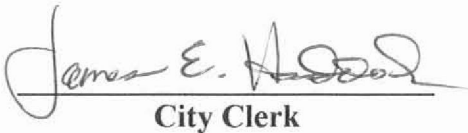
Licenses issued pursuant to this Article may be obtained from locally authorized veterinarians upon proper vaccination and issuance of certificate of vaccination described in Section 210.240.

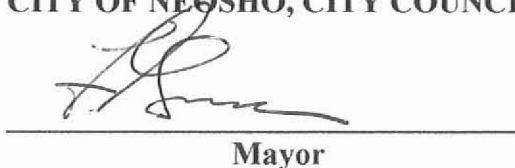
Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon final passage and approval.

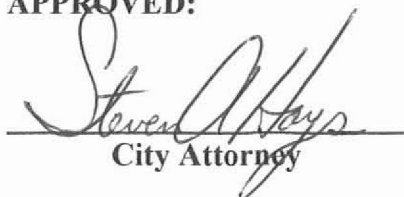
