

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Neosho amending Chapter 705 Sewers and Sewage Disposal, by repealing and replacing Section 705.470 Hauled Waste to modify the hauled waste surcharge for the City of Neosho.

WHEREAS, the City commissioned Allgeier, Martin and Associates, Inc. to perform Water and Sanitary Sewer Utility Rate Studies on or about November 15, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Allgeier, Martin and Associates, Inc. delivered the results of said studies on or about March 2023, a copy of the same being attached hereto and incorporated by reference as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City held a public hearing regarding the adoption of said recommendations of said studies on August 5, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to adopt the recommendations of said studies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEOSHO, MISSOURI, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 705.470 Hauled Waste be repealed and replaced with a new Section 705.470 Hauled Waste to modify the rates for hauled waste read as follows:

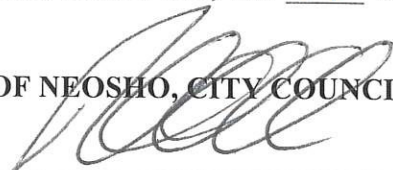
“Section 705.470 Hauled Waste”

“Hauled waste will be charged at a value of thirty-one and 35/100 dollars (\$31.35) per one thousand (1,000) gallons.”

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

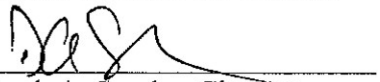

PURPOSE:

To request an amendment to Chapter 705: Section 705.470 Hauled Waste

BACKGROUND:

In November 2011, Council approved an increase in hauled waste to \$20.00 per 1,000 gallons. Prior to that increase this rate had not been updated since 1992. With the increase in rates and expenses to treat hauled waste, Staff proposes to increase the hauled waste charged at a value of thirty-one dollars and thirty-five cents (\$31.35) per one thousand (1,000) gallons. This is the rate charged on other businesses for sewage disposal.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends Council approve the amendment to the City Code.
