**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 200 POLICE, ARTICLE I, SECTION 200.015 CHIEF OF POLICE AND ASSISTANT CHIEF OF POLICE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT OF THE CITY OF NEW HAVEN, MISSOURI**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 1282 of the City of New Haven established residency requirements for the Chief of Police, Assistant Chief of Police, and Full-time Police Officers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Aldermen desires to amend said residency requirements of the Chief of Police, Assistant Chief of Police, and Full-time Police Officers; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF NEW HAVEN, MISSOURI, as follows:**

**SECTION ONE.**

Chapter 200 Police, Article 1. Generally. Section 200.015. Chief of Police and Assistant Chief of Police Residency Requirements is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**SECTION TWO.**

All ordinances or parts of ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION THREE.**


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
