**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE VI OF CHAPTER 18 “STREET  
VACATION PROCEDURES” OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NEW  
BUFFALO, MICHIGAN IN ORDER TO CLARIFY AVAILABLE  
VACATION PROCEDURES**

THE CITY OF NEW BUFFALO ORDAINS:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 39 of Article VI, Chapter 18 of the Code of Ordinances, City of New Buffalo, Michigan, is hereby amended in its entirety to read:

**Section 18-39. Initiation of proceedings.**

Proceedings for the vacation, discontinuance or abolishment of any street, alley, public ground, or part thereof, may be initiated (1) by the City Council as allowed by law, or (2) by the owners of more than 2/3 of the property abutting the part of the street, alley or public ground to be vacated subject to the procedures as set forth in this chapter.

Section 2. Publication and Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City, and shall be effective 20 days after its enactment or upon publication, whichever is later.
