ORDINANCE NO. (A)
OF 2014

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 417
OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORWICH

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Norwich, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 417 of the Code of the City of Norwich, Public Market, as adopted on August 14, 1933 and subsequently amended, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
