Chairperson Judie Wright called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. A quorum was present. The minutes from the June meeting were accepted and approved.

Correspondence:

- Melanye Rockwell of 65 Silver St. Norwich addressed the commission requesting they look at the south entrance leading into Weiler Park, as there are no warning signs to alert motorists of the entrance. Melanye runs a day care, walks about 15 children to and from the park, and is concerned for the safety of the children. Members to view the entrance and ACP Burlison to contact DPW for sign options.
- Leslie Joscelyn 8 State St. contacted the commission regarding vehicles parking on State St. blocking the view when she is backing out of her driveway. Members to view the driveway and make a recommendation.
- Chenango County has requested three reserved parking slots for the D.A.'s office and County Court Judges. In addition one law enforcement reserved parking slot was also requested for West Park Pl on the southwest corner. The signs would be lettered to limit the reserved parking from Monday-Friday 8-5 p.m. Frank Revoir made a motion to approve the reserved parking, seconded by Brian Doliver. Chenango County to be notified.
- Received a letter from Robert Mason, Director of the City of Norwich Youth Bureau requesting a break in the fence near the skate park to encourage motorists to park in the parking lot and not on the street on Borden Ave. Members to view the section of fence and make a recommendation.

Old Business:

- The commission discussed the ongoing parking problem on Locust St. between Eaton Ave. and Hayes St. Motorists are allowed to park on both sides of the street restricting the flow of traffic. Motion by Brian Doliver to post temporary no parking signs on the on the East side of the street to see if that relieves the problem, seconded by Christina Edwards. All in favor. ACP Burlison to post temporary no parking signs. No parking signs will be posted on Wednesday September 17, along with the PD speed trailer and a traffic counter on Locust Street between Hayes St. and Eaton Ave.
- Contact DPW to have the tree sign located on the north entrance into the city relocated to provide a better view of the 30 mph speed limit sign as you enter the city. ACP Burlison to contact DPW. NYS DOT erected a 30 mph caution sign prior to entering into the city warning motorist of 30 mph zone.

New Business:

- Brian Doliver reports the residents on Guernsey St. north of Fair St. are dissatisfied with the No Parking sign that was erected after being down for so long.

Motion by Frank Revoir to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Brian Doliver, meeting adjourned at 7:47 p.m. Next meeting will be October 8, 2014 at 7:00 p.m.
