Acting Chairperson Frank Revoir called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m. A quorum was present. Motion by Brian Golden to accept the minutes from the September meeting, seconded by Christine Edwards. All in Favor.

Correspondence:

- Shawn Witt, William Ostrom and Angel Connell discussed their concerns regarding the No Parking sign replaced on Guernsey Street, north east of the Fair Street intersection. The sign was down for a number of months and was recently replaced. They requested the section of the street be study to see if the No Parking sign could be removed to allow for more on street parking. ACP Burlison is going to see if the speed trailer can be placed on Guernsey Street for a speed study. Traffic commission members were asked to review the area before the next meeting in November.

Old Business:

- The commission reviewed the data provided to the commission from the police speed trailer and the traffic counter placed for a one-week period on Locust Street. Members decided to speak to the residents on Locust Street to see if no parking signs were placed on one side of the street how they would feel about.
- No action will be taken on the State Street parking complaint.
- ACP Burlison to contact DPW and request Playground or Children at play signs be posted on the north and south ends of Weiler Park on Borden Ave. to alert motorist of the park.
- The commission discussed and requests a gateway from the skate park to Weiler Park encouraging motorist to park in the skate park and walk

to Weiler Park. The gateway would allow easier access to Weiler Park. ACP Burlison to contact DPW.

New Business:

- No Parking sign complaint from Shawn Witt, William Ostrom Angel Connell.
- Traffic Commission members were asked to review the Newton Ave. Prospect Street intersection regarding the stop and yield sign placement before the next meeting in November.
