Winter Programs: Sign up for remaining winter programs will be Wednesday December 2nd at 6:00. The Elks will sponsor Saturday bowling for grades 2nd – 4th. There will be a winter session starting after January 1st, but no fall program. Arrangements have been made for coaches for baseball and softball preseason practices at the soccer center. Family Lanes in the south plaza will be the site of the after school Wednesday bowling for grades 5th – 12th. Arrangements for dance instruction have been difficult. Volleyball will also be held.

Skating Facility: One attendant will be returning to the rink this winter, a second attendant position is unfilled. R. Mason reported that a grant award for \$1,457.14 has been received for a new ice skate sharpener. This will replace the nearly 80 year old antique sharpener. The rink will open when conditions permit, typically December into January.

Colgate Hockey Trip/Colonia Theatre Movie: Plans for a Colgate hockey trip will be delayed until after the first of the year. The proposed sponsorship of a free movie at the Colonia Theatre has also been put off until after January 1st.
