The Free showing of "Finding Nemo" is cosponsored by Rita's Earth Day Celebration. The movie is free; however seating is limited to 250. Tickets are required, but they can be picked up at the Youth Bureau or Finance Office at City Hall. Parents with small children are encouraged to attend with them. Adults and chaperones need tickets as well. The free admission does not include concessions.
