Chairperson Judi Wright called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. A quorum was present. There was a motion by Frank Revoir to accept the minutes from the May, 2016 meeting, seconded by Christine Edwards. All in Favor.

Correspondence:

- Jen Foster addressed the commission about relocating a no parking sign about 20-30 feet south of its current location for a second time before the commission took action.
- Received a request from Tracy Rotundo to review the parking problem on Hickok Ave. when vehicles park on both sides of the street restricting the flow of traffic and causing problems when backing out of driveways.

Old Business:

- American Legion Directional Sign – in progress.
- Common Council approved King St. Stop sign and playground signs, Signs ordered.
- Chairperson Judi Wright is working with City Codes and B.I.D. on drafting a letter to all landlords using city parking lots for tenants in the B.I.D. district. In Progress.
- The stop sign for the intersection of Lackawanna and Silver St. has been approved and ordered. The street marking will be completed in the fall of 2016.

- Commission members working on a solution for the speeding traffic on Grove Ave. Pending.
- Motion by Frank Revoir to move the no parking here to corner signs at the intersection of East Main Street and Grove Ave. back 109' on the west side and 93' east side of the intersection. Pending Council approval.
- The commission choose not to take any action on the request to move the No parking here to corner sign back from the intersection of Fair and Canasawacta Street upon the request of Jen Foster.
- Members discussed the on street traffic issue on Midland Dr. in front of the Middle school when school is being released. Motorist are standing/parked sometime three wide causing a traffic congestion. In progress.
- ACP Burlison reported from June 3 until June 8 Grove Ave. had 2708 vehicles pass though the street.

New Business:

- Edith Revoir, d/b/a Valley View nursing home, addressed the commission about the hedge at the intersection of Park/Mitchell St. The growth of the hedge is restricting the line of sight for motorist travelling east on Mitchell St. pulling into the parking lot of the facility. Edith as the commission to review the intersection to see if there was a solution. ACP Burlison to speak to Codes. Members to review the intersection before the next meeting.
- Motion by Richard Natoli to post the south side of Hickok Ave. from North Broad St. to the RxR track with No Parking this side. Seconded by Frank Revoir. There is an ongoing problem when motorist park on both sides of the street choking off large vehicles using the street. School buses and large delivery vans can't pass safely when traffic is parked on both sides of the street. Also residents are having difficulties backing out of their driveways safety when both sides of the street are used for parking. Recommendation send to council.
