Chairperson Judie Wright called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm. A quorum was present. There was a motion by Richard Natoli to accept the minutes from the September, 2017 meeting, seconded by Frank Revoir. All in Favor. (Motion was based on the amendment/correction of the minutes.)

Correspondence:

- Letter received from Office Manager Charyl Hanson from CRM Rental Management, Inc. of Golden Age Apartments requesting permission to install a crosswalk between building A and B in 2018. See attached letter and photo. Commission discussed the crosswalk and forwarded the request to Carl Ivarson, DPW.

Old Business:

- Commission discussed the two crosswalk patterns proposed by NYDOT, and elected to side with Carl Iverson on the placement of the solid lines on the outside if the brick pattern.
- Members discussed the street lights at the crosswalk of Howard Johnson's to see what light gave off the best illumination. Tabled until the November meeting.
- Alderman Caldwell reported no new or on going traffic issues on Locust St. because of the on-going street construction.
- Richard Natoli discussed revisiting the 12 am to 6 am no parking ordinance to see if there was any reason it started November 1 and ended April 15. ACP Burlison to research the back ground on the start and end dates.
- Members discussed the lack of posted hospital signs leading into the City of Norwich and wanted to know who post the signs and what the best practice was for the signage. Members discussed signs should be posted directing motorist to the main streets leading to the hospital with the most direct route. ACP Burlison to contact Carl Iverson and NYS DOT for guidance.
- Members discussed the request for No Parking on one side of Sharon Dr. Motion by Frank Revoir if 75% of the Sharon Street residents approve no parking on the north side of the street it would be forwarded to the Common Council for approval.

New Business:

- Alderman Caldwell requested a No Parking Here to Corner sign on Hayes St. on the northwest corner of Hayes and Elm St.
- Alderman Caldwell reported the residents of Chenango Ave. requested No Parking on the south side of Chenango Ave.
