Chairperson Judi Wright called the meeting to order at 7:11 p.m. A quorum was present. Motion by Frank Revoir to accept the minutes from the June meeting, Seconded by Linda Hanson. All in favor.

Old Business:

- NYSDOT Danielle Besso has a map for hospital sign placement for all roadways that lead into the city, directing motorist to the hospital without delay.
- Locust St. No Parking signs on the East side north of Hayes St. have been removed and seem to be working. Tabled until October's meeting.
- Chenango Ave. no parking signs posted on south side of the street.
- 3 Stop signs posted at the intersection of Court/Fair St.
- So. Mitchell St. posted no parking on the east and west side.
- NYSDOT crosswalk project for North and South Broad St. pending.
- LED street light project pending.
- No further action taken on Berry Street request, Roots and Wings has restructured and large delivery trucks have been limited.

New Business:

- East Main St./Hubbard Ave. railroad crossing, motorists are parking too close to the railroad tracks causing a safety issue with locomotives operating on the tracks. Current ordinance in place, no parking on Hubbard Ave. on the east side from East Main St. 206 feet south. Members advised to review the intersection for discussion during the next meeting.
- Alderman Brian Doliver reports Ward 2 is having an issue with a commercial tractor parking curbside on Cortland St. limiting the visibility for residents backing or pulling out of their driveways. ACP Burlison to check with other municipalities to see if they have any restrictions.
- Members discussed the current no parking ordinances from 12 midnight until 6:00 a.m. A request was made to have Highway Superintendent Pepe present at the October 10th meeting. ACP Burlison is going to contact him.
- Richard Natoli reports there are no parking here to corner signs on east end of Clinton St. south side that are faded and can't be read. Motorists are parking in the no parking area. ACP Burlison to contact DPW.
- Members discussed CWS has a crosswalk going through the middle of their parking lot and it ends in the center of Midland Dr. Chairperson Judi Wright is going to contact CWS to get further details.
- Alderman Brian Doliver discussed the possibility of permanent speed radar signs placed on Midland Dr. on the north and south side of the school to warn motorists of their speed. ACP Burlison to contact a vendor for quotes.

Motion by Frank Revoir to adjourn meeting, seconded by Brian Doliver, meeting adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
