Chairperson Eric Warren called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. The minutes from July's meeting were not approved.

**Correspondence:**

Two letters received reporting a parking sign missing from the corner of Walnut/Diamond St. ACP Burlison reports DPW was already aware and working on replacement of the sign.

**Old Business:**

- ACP Burlison reports NYSDOT denied the request to move the stop bar on South Broad St. for commercial traffic turning west onto West Main St.
- Request for a wheel chair sign has been forwarded to the common council for review.
- Crosswalk making on Midland Dr. /Davis St. pending.
- Curbside parking at the dog park, River St. is scheduled to be repaved and the issues could be addressed at that time.

- Tree Removal on Birdsall Street, still pending. NYSEG has request.
- Motion by Judi Wright to table any further discussion about Hubbard Ave. until more information is available about the train schedule, seconded by Fred Gee. All in favor.
- Winter ban requested at the common council for approval or rejection.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- Members discussed a potential problem on North Broad St. while stopped at the main four. When a motorist is stopped in traffic on North Broad St. waiting to turn right onto West Main St., some motorist are using the dead space as a turn lane almost causing an accident for the motorist who is in the correct lane of travel. Motion by Christine Edwards to have NYSDOT review the intersection to see if signage or street markings would assist with the issue. Seconded by Judi Wright. All in favor.
- ACP Burlison brought up the discussion of Four Ways Stop signs at Guernsey/Fair and Mechanic and Silver. No further discussion by the commission.
- Members were advised Terri Grey-Wessels has resigned.
