4. New Filter Plant SPDES Permit – No updates
5. Rt 12 watermain replacement – The City submitted a grant application to USDA for \$2.8 million to cover a \$4 M watermain replacement project. City also submitted to other agencies for grant money to help support the project. Supt. Pepe stated he had concerns meeting the project deadline due to the serious supply shortages in the US right now. He stated ductile iron pipe lead times were 12 months or more.
