RESOLUTION #48-2008

**AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT FOR CONTINUING USE OF PORTIONS OF
COURT STREET MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT BY HOTEL PROPERTY AT
75 NORTH BROAD STREET**

Ald. Jeffrey introduced the following and **moved** its adoption:

WHEREAS, the City of Norwich has previously had agreements with owners of the hotel property at 75 North Broad Street for the use of the Court Street municipal parking lot by the hotel; and

WHEREAS, such previous parking agreements have expired; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council believes that it is in the interest of the City to enter into a new agreement to allow hotel use of certain portions of Court Street municipal parking lot; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council also believes that it is in the interest of the City for there to be public access along the vehicular passageway at the northern end of the hotel property; and

WHEREAS, the proposed action contemplated by this resolution may appropriately be classified as a Type 2 action according to the requirements of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA); now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Mayor, acting under the direction of the City Attorney, be and hereby is authorized to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the owner of the hotel property at 75 North Broad Street for the hotel's use of certain portions of the Court Street municipal parking lot and for public access along the vehicular passageway on the northern side of the hotel property.

Seconded by Ald. Deierlein and duly adopted, 6-0, on a roll-call vote.
